

Who can apply: The applicant must be a senior at Old Bridge High School and be related to a member in good standing or a deceased member.

The Barney Shannon Scholarship

Scholarship: \$1,000 stipend awarded to a single HS Student.

Who can apply: The applicant must be a senior at any high school and be related to a member in good standing or a deceased member.

How to apply

The student can apply by writing a letter outlining his/her HS accomplishments, such as AP classes, academic awards, extracurricular activities & sports, class academic standing, plans for college and anticipated major. And of course, he/she must indicate their relationship to the FSOS. A letter is required for each scholarship application and yes, students can apply for both.
